Grabador Digital Sentry (Duración– 3 días) (Digital Sentry)

Primera Parte - Introducción al Sistema Operativo Windows XP para proveer al participante con los conocimientos necesarios para la administración e instalación efectiva de un sistema de Digital Sentry. Los puntos a cubrir son: Servicios de MS Windows, Administración del sistema, Monitor de eventos, configuración de conexión a red, Creación y modificación de cuentas de usuario, Uso de herramientas de diagnóstico y observación, Administrador de tareas, Compartiendo recursos, etc. Este parte preliminar es un requisito si no cuenta con una de las siguientes certificaciones: MSCE, MCSA, MCP, MOS, o si aprueba el examen preliminar en-linea.
