Pelco National Defense Authorization Act Compliance List

Background

The National Defense Authorization Act (NDAA) includes provisions to address cybersecurity risks. Section 889 of the NDAA contains the prohibition on certain telecommunications and video surveillance services or equipment from specific vendors. It also contains several provisions that have a major impact on existing and future US Government-related video surveillance deployments. The NDAA ban also extends to other manufacturers in cases in which the video surveillance cameras or systems from the specified vendors are offered under another manufacturer's brand name, which is typical of OEM, ODM and JDM relationships.

Pelco Statement

- Pelco products and accessories are compliant with the NDAA. The products in the list below do not use or deploy critical components including SoCs produced by component vendors that are banned by the NDAA.
- These products are included in GSA contracts and are recommended for US Government applications that are subject to the NDAA.
- Pelco is committed to providing NDAA-compliant products and do not have OEM, ODM and JDM relationships with the named vendors in the NDAA.
